Dear Parents and Carers,
Another busy couple of weeks. Here are some of the highlights.

School Performance data

Last week, the school performance data for the 2018 Key stage 2 results, was officially published. We are delighted with the outcomes that have been achieved, which show that progress scores in all areas have improved and that the school is performing above the national average. Our combined percentage for reading, writing and maths also increased from 55% to 70% which is 6% above the national average. The Inspection Data Summary Report also noted that, *'Junior schools on average, have lower progress scores, which may be for a variety of reasons and should be taken in to account when comparing their results to schools which start educationg their pupils from the beginning of key stage 1.'*

Thank you to all of the families that have been able to attend the Fantastic Finish events this term. The children have loved sharing their learning and we have had excellent feedback across the whole school. Parents have said,
